-Questions about clean time requirements for phone line volunteers. Currently, nothing in our by-laws regarding clean time requirements. Potential to amend by-laws upon further research and discussion. The Region may have clearer guidelines but will need further discussion via region.

-Suggested to ask our RCM team to take some of these questions to the region and inquiry about clean time, duties and qualifications regarding PR and phone line volunteers to help our area gauge our requirements for implementation of phoneline volunteer requirements into our bylaws.

-Training or a workshop was brought up to train volunteers on the phone line. Noted because volunteers will get callers who may be on the verge of self-harm and without appropriate training one will not know how to mediate the situation to offer other resources to the caller(s). Ask our RCM team to request a training workshop back to our area.

-People vaping in meetings was brought up and the concern that there will be the potential of losing meeting spaces. <u>Vaping needs to be treated the same as smoking</u>.
