xv. Open Sharing Session:

- P.O. Box is \$440.00 yearly. The executive body decided to pay six months of that yearly debit and wanted the area's opinions and points of view about whether to keep the current P.O. Box and/or start the process of finding a new one. Several points of information are as follows:
 - 1) The current P.O. Box is extremely oversized for current mail traffic through it.
 - 2) The accumulated total of mail traffic in the past two years has surmounted to several letters and primary flyers/junk mail.
 - 3) Current Post office does not have any more available (smaller) P.O. Box.

4) The yearly debit has gone up each year. Estimated to increase to closer to \$500.00. -As long as the Area is okay with moving forward with finding a more financial effective P.O. Box, An AD-HOC will be created to gather and then present more information to the area to help the area make an informed decision.

- Back to Basics clarified who their GSR and Alternate GSR are.
- Chris T.- Regarding the music event he came to area last month seeking advice, He has come back with more information and budget. He stated that his home group, Primary Purpose, is very supportive with the manpower and logistics, just not able to help with the finances. But will be sponsoring this musical event on June 30th. The numbers came to \$592.00. Most of the funds are going towards food, donations to the venue, flyer graphic design, a 10% miscellaneous buffer was included in the total amount. Several people asked questions and a conversion ensued regarding the above request and more information about the musical event proceeded. Suggestions were made on how to obtain funding. Suggestions were made on how to lower total event costs. Suggested to

lower the initial request amount of \$592.00. Questions were asked regarding accountability of the money. Finances would liaison through Primary Purpose home group and whomever helps support this event (i.e. the area or one of the subcommittees) all donations from the event will return to that body. It was pointed out that this musical event will happen, regardless of financial help from the area. A motion has been submitted to go back to the Home Groups to vote in the amount of \$300.00 to help finance the proposed musical event.
