Hi RANA Family,

I attended the VRCC meeting on May 17, 2026, in person at the Charlottesville UVA Hospital from 12-4:00 PM. Opening positions are Treasurer and Secretary; however, Treasurer Fred Hitti from the New Dominion Area was voted in today. Eight directors are present, so the quorum was met. Executive committee reports were read. In January 2026, the 42nd AVCNA only had 250-300 people who attended due to the state of emergency winter weather that occurred that weekend. For 2028, Virginia Beach grabbed the bid for the 43rd. It will be held at the Founders Inn in January 2028. We also voted to change our name to Central Atlantic Regional Convention. The open secretary position requirements are 2 years clean, working the 12 steps, 12 traditions, and 1-year VRCC service experience. The web servant Ann V. gave an informative presentation. I forwarded the Secretary's email to Noelle, our secretary.
